Background: Juzoor for Health and Social Development (Juzoor) is implementing a one year project aiming to improve the delivery of legal, health, and social services for women victims of violence and those at risk of violence. The proposed project is based on Juzoor extensive experience in promoting women’s rights, legislative reviews, and stakeholder consultation. It is part of Juzoor and WCLAC's project on combating violence against women, first launched in 2009. The two organizations, in collaboration with civil society organizations and government structures, have developed a model of integrated legal-health-social service referral system, which has been successfully piloted in Ramallah and Jericho

The goal of the project is to contribute to the protection of women against violence, through strengthening the delivery of legal, health, and social services for women victims of violence and those at risk of violence.

Objective of the activity:

Update the national referral protocols during the implementation process with national stakeholders and partners focusing on women with disabilities who are victims of GBV.

The consultant will carry out the following tasks:

1. Overview on the current situation and the special needs of women's with disabilities who are subjected to GBV.
2. Review the national referral protocols in relation to women with disability perspective
3. Based on the need assessment and the national referral protocols review, the consultant will add section for women with disabilities in the referral protocols targeting the health – social – police – and the code of ethics referral protocols.
4. The component of the referral protocols will include screening and assessment for violence, intervention mechanisms, treatment and protection and the referral mechanisms for other organizations.
5. Updating the organizational mapping manual with names and addresses of organizations and institutions that works with women with disabilities.
6. Presenting the updated referral protocols to partners and stakeholders and get feedback from them.
7. The consultant will provide the technical committee and the project team with the needed training to compile the needed data and information.

Comprehensive, final report of the referral protocols with Women with disabilities section integrated components will be submitted on the 30th of June 2013.
